

## **EMROG Monday Night Net Script** (Revised 12/17/2024)

**This is (Your Callsign), I will begin the EMROG/ARES net in [10] minutes. A clear frequency for the net will be appreciated.**

**This is (Your Callsign), I will begin the EMROG/ARES net in [5] minutes. A clear frequency for the net will be appreciated.**

### **(Preamble)**

**This is     (Your Callsign)     Net Control Operator for the weekly training net from the Fort Bend County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. The Emergency Management Radio Operators Group and District 1 Fort Bend County ARES.**

**This net regularly meets each Monday evening with the exception of the second Monday of the month at 7:30 PM to introduce Radio Amateurs to, and train in, emergency communications and net operations. This net will also activate on an as-needed basis when conditions merit. This net is open to all licensed Radio Amateurs. This repeater uses a negative offset and a PL tone of 167.9 Hz. If the repeater goes down, we will switch to 146.58 MHz simplex. You can also join the net on Echo Link by connecting to KD5YOU-R**

**For digital check-ins please send a Winlink message to: K0LTB, NT5SM, KA9IKK and WD8RZA-1. Utilize VHF, UHF and HF bands whenever possible. Be sure to list the mode and band used in the subject line. The body of the message should contain the frequency and gateway used. If possible, use the ICS-213 message form.**

### **(Check-ins)**

**This is a directed net and all calls made to the net will go through this net control station. When calling Net Control, speak slowly, and give your call phonetically using ITU phonetics. During this net if anyone has emergency traffic break into the net using the prowords “BREAK-BREAK” or your call sign with “EMERGENCY TRAFFIC” and you will be recognized. Is there any emergency or priority traffic, please call Net Control now, over.**

**Net Control will now take ECHO Link check-ins, Echo Link only, please call Net Control now, over.**

**Net Control will now take all other check-ins including visiting stations. State if you have traffic or announcements and state if you are an NTS liaison when checking in. If there is any radiogram traffic that needs to be passed hold it until the net concludes. over.**

**(Traffic)**

**Call stations with traffic and announcements listed above and have them pass their traffic to the net.**

**(Training)**

**We will now proceed with tonight's training.**

**(Conclusion)**
